### SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA: Qualifications for obtaining scholarships are as followed

- Student demonstrating commitment to community service
- Meeting the criteria for "Qualified Student"
- Interview

#### **Qualified Student' is defined as:**

- High School Seniors living in the following Texas School Districts:
  - 1. Aransas Pass ISD
  - 2. Ingleside ISD
  - 3. High School Seniors of LOOM (2063) and WOTM (1972) members who do not live in these districts (i.e. sons, daughters, grand children)

## These scholarships will NOT be based on any of the following criteria:

- Gender, Race, Religion, Income, Grade point average, class rank
- Extracurricular school activities, Grammar, Field of Study, financial need
- Fraternal affiliation (no affiliation with the 'Loyal Order of Moose' is required to be eligible for these scholarships)

- Accredited colleges, Universities, Vocational, Technical and/ or Trade Schools before the scholarship can be granted.

\*These scholarships can be given directly to the student if the student so wishes
