Scholarships shall be in the fo	orm of payme	nts distributed directly to the college.		

Scholarships shall be in the form of payments distributed directly to the college, university, trade school or institution. The payments will be in two (2) installments. One being for the fall semester and one for the spring semester. Students receiving a scholarship must attend the accredited college or trade school in the fall semester immediately following graduation in order to receive any funds. The time deadline on obtaining the scholarship funds from the Treasurer is October 1st following May/June graduation and February 1st for the spring installment. To receive the 1st installment the scholarship recipient must show proof of registration for the fall semester. To receive the 2nd installment the scholarship recipient must show proof of registration for the spring semester as well as a transcript showing proof of unrestricted academic standing for the previous fall semester.
